

COLOR-CODING THE BIBLE



The word “domain” is used here regarding the 8 spheres of culture as referenced in the Bible. The 8 domains are:

Government

Education

Family

Religion

Communication

Arts and Entertainment

Science and Technology

Economy

Choose a different color for each domain (or, you can choose other topics for color-coding your Bible, as well. The possibilities are endless!)

Colored pencils work well.

Good places to start: Proverbs chapters 10 - 31, and Deuteronomy

- Begin by writing your personal stance regarding the domain/topic you’ve chosen.
- As you study, submit all your thoughts and opinions to the Lord of Truth.
- Don’t study for ammunition or defense! Study for truth and freedom!
- Be consistent – if a verse refers to more than one domain/topic, mark the differences consistently by using distinct colors.
- Idea for deeper study: after studying Economics, read through the Financial Times or Newsweek or The Economist, comparing what you read to what the Bible says.
