

## CREATIVE IDEAS FOR OBSERVING BIBLE PERSONALITIES



*Note: these ideas are great for families, mealtime conversations, home groups, classes, etc.*

Each person tells ways in which the others are like specific Bible characters.

Each person tells which Bible personality with whom they personally identify, and why.

When you observe a Bible personality, take note of their good AND bad traits. (Children often think that people are either totally bad or totally good. This will help them learn that Bible characters were human, just like themselves, and teach them how people can realistically relate to God.)

Dramatize stories from the Bible. This can be as simple as reading a Bible story word-for-word as others act it out, or briefly telling the high points of a story, such as, "Lazarus! Come Forth!!!"  
Props are optional...but more fun :)

Bible Character Charades - Study Bible characters as a family or group and write down things you learn about them on separate index cards. When you have at least 20 cards, play charades by guessing which person in the Bible you are imitating.

As you read through the Proverbs, think of Bible stories and personalities that illustrate the truth or principle presented in a specific proverb.
